


Key verse - JUDGES 21:25

SUMMARY

God raised leaders at certain times to rid the Israelites of foreign invaders who came into the land as a result of the people's disobedience to God and rejection of his kingship a theme that occurs early and often in the book.



The cycle of the Israelites' sin in Judges: (1) they turned from God; (2) God responded with judgment; (3) they cried out for mercy; (4) God delivered them through judges.

The Hebrew word for "cried out" in <u>Judges 4:3</u> is **tsa'aq**, and it means "to cry out in distress." The Israelites were not repenting when they cried, just asking God for deliverance.
